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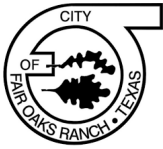

CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL  
ELECTION HELD MAY 2, 2026, IN THE CITY OF FAIR OAKS RANCH, TEXAS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Fair Oaks Ranch, Texas called a General Election to be held in the City on May 2, 2026, to elect Council Member Places 2 and 6; and

**WHEREAS**, applications to be placed on the ballot were received and filed with the City Secretary for the aforementioned council places; and

**WHEREAS**, after said election the Presiding Judge of Kendall County holding said elections made the returns of the results thereof as follows, and said returns being made according to law, and it being shown that written notice of said elections was posted for the time and in the manner provided by law, and all other proceedings pertaining to said elections having been shown to have been done and performed at and within the manner provided by law, and all papers pertaining thereto having been returned and filed with the City Secretary and no protest or objection being made to or regarding any matter pertaining to said election; and

**WHEREAS**, on the 12th day of May 2026, at a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Fair Oaks Ranch, Texas, with at least two council members being present, the meeting was called to order to open, examine, and canvass the official returns of the general election held in the City on the above-mentioned date, for the election of Council Member Place 2, and Council Member Place 6.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIR OAKS RANCH, TEXAS:**

- Section 1.** It appearing that **Keith Rhoden** was duly elected Council Member, Place 2. Said named candidate ran unopposed and received all votes cast for the office of Council Member, Place 2, and is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve a three-year term, subject to taking the Oath of Office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.
- Section 2.** It appearing that **Jonathan Swarek** was duly elected Council Member, Place 6. Said named candidate received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Council Member, Place 6, and is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve a three-year term, subject to taking the Oath of Office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.
- Section 3.** That this canvass and declaration of results of said General Election be entered in the Minutes of the City Council and the Election Register and that said officers, after being qualified and having taken the Oath, shall serve in their respective offices for the terms stated herein, and thereafter until a successor is duly elected and qualified.
- Section 4.** That the recitals contained in the preamble hereto are hereby found to be true and such recitals are hereby made a part of this resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the City Council.
- Section 5.** If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City Council hereby declares that this resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.
- Section 6.** That it is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

**Section 7.** All resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provision of this resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

**Section 8.** This resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

**Section 9.** This resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its final passage, and it is so resolved.
